Thus, emerged the concept of the Medical Home-a comprehensive facility integrating medical, nursing, and physiotherapy services under one roof.

Collaborating in this visionary endeavor was Mr. Jayantbhai Chapaneri, a distinguished engineer acclaimed for his outstanding contributions to



social welfare. His tireless efforts and passion for social services were evident in initiatives ranging from blood banks and eye banks to the establishment of a crematorium and a school for mentally challenged children. His multifaceted contributions ranging from healthcare to education have left an enduring legacy, making him a key figure in the social landscape of PARDI. A Catalyst Moment for Change Mr. Chapaneri's Social Engagements & Dr. Mehta's Compassionate Vision

Dedicated social worker Mr. Chapaneri was a regular visitor to Dr. Mehta's hospital, mainlyengaging in discussions about various ongoing social projects. One day, as Jayantbhai awaited Dr. Mehta's presence in his consulting chamber, Dr. Mehta entered, visibly burdened by the weight of a recent conversation with relative of a bedridden stroke patient. He revealed a struggle faced by daughter-in-lawfor optimum carerequired for her father-in-law.she sacrificed her job for caregiving duties. Despite substantial resources and financial expenditure, hisrecovery remained slower than expected. This situation was purely attributed to the lack of a professional care approach and the absence of specialized services. Dr. Mehta, driven by his compassionate vision, expressed his profound concern aboutfrequent incidentsand seeking assistance to address this pressing issue.Dr. Mehta envisions a comprehensive solution that can offer support under one roof during thesechallenging times oflife, yethe is grappling with how to make it happen.

Unified vision and synergy

Mirroring these sentiments, Mr. Chapaneri resonated deeply with Dr Mehta'sconcern and eagerly became ready for supportrevealing an unspoken alignment of their thoughts of caring. The synchronicity of their visions and collaborative effort prompted a joint visit to a facility in Wada, Maharashtra, which, unfortunately, fell short of providing the care which Dr Mehta envisioned. Post this visit, Dr. Mehta elaborated on his distinctive concept, a vision cultivated throughout his professional career. He proposed that this approach could be the pioneering model and first of its kind in Gujarat and possibly in all of India.

Over the next 4-5 months, Dr. Mehta and Mr. Chapaneri were engaged in numerous meetings and discussions. This profound exchange led to an emotional connection with Shri. Jayantbhai that transformed Dr. Mehta's impassioned dream into a feasible reality. The result was the crystallisation of a definitive plan of action. Their commitment extended beyond the medical needs, focusing on comfort, nursing support, and emotional assistance. The aim was to nurture the dignity of the bedridden individuals and instil hope for a better tomorrow.

A Visionary Proposal Creating Medical Home for Comprehensive Care















At a crucial juncture, Mr. Jayantbhai proposed the inclusion of Mr. VinaybhaiDesai and Mr. Kishorebhai Pandya into the noble cause. Recognising the need for diverse expertise, Dr. Pratap Thosar, Mr. Sharadbhai Desai, and Mr. Nitinbhai Desai were also invited to contribute their valuable insights. The pivotal moment occurred during the first informal meeting held at Mehta Hospital on 10/07/2009.Dr. Mehta, in collaboration with Mr. Jayantbhai, presented a visionary plan to the esteemed dignitaries present in the meeting. Dr. Mehta emphasised the necessity for a facility catering to bedridden individuals or patients in need of comprehensive care, encompassing

stressed that such services were challenging to provide at home, often delaying recovery or incomplete rehabilitation. During the meeting, Dr. Mehta enlightened all dignitaries about the extensive study and research conducted by them, Dr Mehtabriefed the comprehensive roadmap to actualise the concept in with creation of such facilityin Pardi. Despite starting on a small scale, the plan was designed to be scalable as needed in the future. With a preliminary plan laid out, Dr. Mehta sought consensus from everyone present, proposing to move forward with this transformative and essential concept. Without hesitation, everyone readily accepted, approved and wholeheartedly committed to move forward. Subsequently, all the dignitaries present during the meeting became founder Trustees of the initiative.

Formation, Registration and Evolution of Trust

This gathering marked the shaping of the vision of Dr. Mehta and Mr. Jayantbhai, leading to the formal establishment of the Helping Hand Foundation. A collective suggestion for the trust's name encapsulated its essence. The term "Medical Home" was coined by Dr Mehta denoting a hospital like facility in homely environment. The emblem of the trust was developed collaboratively by Dr. Mehta and Mr.Jayantbhai, portraying waves as a representation of the sea of difficulties raised to the lights of the Sun by providing a helping hand.

The journey commenced with Mr.



Jayantbhai wholead the laborious task of registering the trust within an impressive twomonth period. The foundation evolved into the

Helping Hand Charitable Trust with registration under Charity commissioner of Valsad on 09/09/2009. Mr. Chapaneri's unwavering dedication and genuine concern were instrumental in turning impassioned dream into realitywith creation of the MEDICAL HOME.

Rapid Implementation of the Medical Home Facility

A Vision in action

After the formation of the trust, a heartwarming gesture from Dr. Thosar came forth—he offered his hospital premises to initiate the Medical Home concept. Dr. Mehta, fuelled by the vision, was ready to contribute Rs.2 to 2.5 lakhs to kickstart this revolutionary concept. The journey took an auspicious turn when our first supporter Mrs. Vimlaben Lalbhai of Atul group promptly offered a generous donation of rs 1,51,000/-. in first meeting with Dr Mehta and Mr. Chapaneri. Subsequently, Shri Nitinbhai Desai's commendable efforts secured an additional Rs 4 Lac from Dr Savitriben Champaklal Trust. Adding to this support Mr. Kishorebhai Pandya generously donated beds and essential accessories. This collective effort propelled the project into practical action, commencing on 15/11/2009 again in an astonishingly short span of only 35 days

by an untiring effort made by Mr. Chapaneri for this execution.

The care protocols and guidelines, complying with all rules and regulations, were meticulously formulated by Dr. Mehta. The daily operations and activities were diligently monitored by a dedicated team comprising of Dr. Praful Mehta, Shri, Jayantbhai Chapaneri, Shri Vinaybhai Desai, Dr. Pratap Thosar, and Shri. Nitinbhai Desai.

Their commitment manifested in their daily rounds and continuous engagement, with a significant portion of their time invested to ensure the seamless operation of the Medical Home. Late. Dr. J. R. Parmar, seniormost respected family physician of Pardi who volunteered free service by taking daily rounds with examination of all patients and profoundly engaged in conversation with all inmates. This rapid and well-coordinated implementation showcased the collective determination in turning an idea into reality.

Dr Mehta expresses eternal gratitude to Shri. Jayantbhai for his dedicated work and contributions in creating such facility in PARDI. Without his active involvement, the progress made in the initial phases would not have

Inauguration and Unprecedented Acceptance

The inauguration took place on 10/01/2010, graced by the presence of Dr. Tushar A Chaudhary, Union Minister of Indiaalong with other dignitaries, Shri. C.R.Patil M.P., Smt. Darshanaben Jardosh, M.P.ShriDolatrai Desai, MLA, Shri



Lalubhai Patel, MP, Smt. Ushaben Patel MLA and shri. Hariprasaddas Swamiji.

Initially, there were apprehensions about how society would receive this new concept of caring for bedridden individuals. However, the response surpassed all expectations. Astonishingly, on the very first day, two patients were

This advertisement meticulously detailed the essence of the visionary concept, explaining its advantages and providing comprehensive information about each admitted patient distinctly outlining their condition at the time of admission and their present status of recovery. This transparent communication with the general population effectively conveyed the success stories, solidifying the trust and acceptance of this innovative and successful approach to caregiving.

From that day forward, our Medical Home experienced an unending waiting list, consistently at full capacity.

"Continuous Capacity Dilemma"

Decision Crossroads Shaping the Path Ahead with Redefining Commitments

After the successful implementation of our pilot project, we received commendable appreciation for the improvements observed in the bedridden individuals. The results were nothing short of spectacular, indicating the effectiveness of our approach. Encouraged by this success, we plannedto expand our services to include various new facilities and activities for our inmates which were envisioned at the time of conceptualisation. However, our plans were hindered by other factors mainly space constraints.

Within a year, on realization of the growing demand and the need for enhanced facilities, we found ourselves at a crucial juncture. We made the difficult decision to retract from purchasing a rented premises despite our earlier commitment.

Recognizing the importance of upholding our commitment, it became necessary to either honour our assurance and purchase this property or seek a buyer who would continue our rent agreement until a suitable space could be secured or vacate the premises altogether. This decision weighed heavily on us as we navigated the delicate balance between fulfilling our promises and meeting the evolving needs of our project. In this critical moment, Shri Vinaybhai Desai's swift action was instrumental. Sensing the urgency of the situation, he readily stepped in and purchased the premises. This proactive move not only relieved the trust from their prior assurance of purchase but also provided the necessary space to expand our services as envisioned

> Expansion Endeavours Acquiring Land and Overcoming Challenges

With successful implementation and demand, our rented 3000 sq. ft. premises became a constraint for accommodating more needy persons

andlimiting execution of our envisioned plans comprehensively. We all Trustees decided to increase our capacity and facilities. All Trustees in their capabilityinitiated efforts on finding a land/premises suitable for our cause. Mr. Jayantbhai, Mr. Vinaybhai, and Dr. Mehtahave actively sought land donors, companies, or associations willing to support our expansion plans. Discussions were held with Mr. Sunilbhai Lalbhai of Atul Ltd, who generously offered 1 acre of land at Chanvai. Additionally, Mr. Jatin Bhai Desai from Balda also offered land. Despite initial enthusiasm, these opportunities did not materialize. With persistent efforts from Mr. Jayantbhai and Shri. Vinaybhai, we were able to procure a substantial 3.5-acre plot adjacent to the bank of River Par by donation. This generous contribution was facilitated by Pardi Bundar Trust by the TrusteesShri Vallabhbhai Patel, Kantibhai Patel, and Ashokbhai Patel. The acquisition of this sizable land has opened doors to transformative possibilities for an expanded and enhanced Medical Home.All legal formalities with Charity commissioner were taken over by Shri. Vinaybhai Desai, Shri. Jayantbhai Chapaneri and Dr Praful Mehta for an amalgamation of Shri Pardi Bandar Trust and Helping hand charitable Trust.

Construction Kick-off: Navigating Challenges with Diligence

The planning phase involved the collaborative efforts of Dr. Mehta, Shri Vinaybhai Desai, and Shri Chapaneri. They meticulously designed the building,

ensuring it felt like a home while not compromising on the basic requirements of a hospital. Bathrooms were specifically designed to allow easy assistance for bathing, featuring hand showers and ample space for manoeuvrability, with no doors but only curtains. Corridors were spacious and an extra space on each floor kept for utilisation by seniors residing on floor. Numerous meetings with the architect, Mr. Yogeshbhai Kelawala, and Mr. Dharmesh Modi were held at his Vapi office, where the trio shared their vision. A heartfelt gratitude is extended to the architect for a marvellous work in designing and planning at free of cost. Moreover, Mr. Sharad Desai's instrumental role in securing Palika permission for building construction was commendable

Project Commencement and Financial Challenges

In visualisation to the pressing societal need and with a substantial plot of land, our vision for the Helping Hand Medical Home involved the establishment of a significant 350-bed facility, to be implemented in phases. The initial phase aimed at accommodating 110 beds, with a projected minimum budget of 1.5 crore. While initiating of the project, reservations arosefrom Dr Mehta's perspectiveconcerning the lack of secured funding or commitments. However, Mr. Jayantbhai showed confidence, assuring that funds would materialize once construction commenced.

Construction Kick-off: Navigating Challenges With Diligence

With the auspicious "BHUMIPUJAN" ceremony on 09/02/2015, construction officially commenced. The construction site and ongoing work were diligently monitored by Dr. Praful Mehta, Shri. Jayantbhai, and Shri. Vinaybhai. Despite ailing health, Mr. Jayantbhai continued monitoring of construction work daily and was present until a day prior to his last breath. This affectionate dedication reflects his deep emotional attachment to the project.





A Heartfelt Tribute to Shri. Jayantbhai for his Legacy and Remarkkable contribution

A special mention is deserving for Late Shri Chapaneri. who passed away on August 31, 2015. His active participation and invaluable contributions will always be remembered and cherished by all those involved in the project. His selfless dedication and relentless pursuit of the project's goals have left a lasting impact, and we are forever indebted to him for his remarkable contribution. His style of working will continue to inspire us all to work tirelessly for this cause.

Financial Challenges: Steering Through Storms

During this time, efforts from Shri Pravibhai G. Desai secured a generous donation of Rs. 50 Lacs from Shantaben Patel, fueling progress. Additionally, a doctor couple Dr. Rameshbhai and Dr. Shilpaben from the USA were impressed with our facilities, decided to stay and serve our residents. They offered a substantial commitment of Rs. 2.5 Crore. Construction preceded at a rapid pace driven by optimism of support. Unfortunately, unforeseen circumstances took a tragic turn with the unexpected demise of Dr. Rameshbhai. This heartbreaking event translated into an incomplete commitment, with only 15 Lacs of the total pledged amount received.

Shri. Miraj Vashi's Role in Overcoming the Challenges.

At this juncture, the construction cost had significantly advanced, reaching approximately 1.2 Crore. The project faced a critical financial situation, which led us to a challenging decision of temporaryhalt of the ongoing

construction. Acknowledging the financial constraints, our primary creditors, the steel supplier KharelCooperative Mandali and contractor Mr. Hardik Desai, demonstrated remarkable cooperation and understanding. Despite the unforeseen hurdles, their courtesy and flexibility alleviated some of the financial pressures, for which we are deeply grateful.

Trustee's Collective Support: Surmounting Obstacles

In an urgent effort to address our outstanding debts, a crucial decision was made to seek a returnable loan from all the trustees.

Dr. Mehta, Ajay Shah, Vinaybhai Desai, Swatiben Lalbhai, and Miraj Vashi promptly supported and contributed for this cause. This collective financial backing, initially intended as an interest free soft loan, was later selflessly converted into a donation to the Trust. Despite the commendable efforts to settle the outstanding dues, challenges persisted in restarting the construction work. However, at this critical juncture, the intervention of Shri Kishorbhai Pandya proved instrumental. With his efforts, The Mumbadevi Mandir Trust, Mumbaigenerously extended a donation of Rs. 25 Lacs. This significant contribution played a important role in resuming the construction work, breathing new life into our transformative project. Subsequently, the project received another substantial boost with a

donation of Rs. 1.1 Crore from the Parsi Gentleman, Shri. Noshirbhai Gotla, facilitated by the dedicated efforts of Daraish Pardiwala and Hemant Bhagat. Additionally, Smt. Shantaben Patel's unwavering commitment to our cause was further demonstrated through a generous donation of another Rs. 50 Lacs. This was a remarkable display of collective support in overcoming obstacles.

Milestone Achieved: Beginning at New Premises

The urgency to move to our new premises prompted the completion of all ground floor work andon the auspicious day of May 7, 2018, we celebrated a significant milestone by successfully relocating all 18 in-house bedridden patients to our new premises. A big task of shifting 18 bedridden patients from the old facility to new premises was carried ou under able guidance of Shri. Nitinbhai Desai and Dr. Neelam Mehta. The initial days were challenging as we navigated the logistics of settling our patients and staff in the new space. Both have playedan instrumental role in exhibiting remarkable dedication for accomplishing this Herculean task. Within a week, they effectively managed

at our facility. Within one month of his stay, he began to show signs of recovery, including being able to consume food normally. Subsequently, we were able to remove his feeding tube, marking another milestone in his journey towards recovery.

The data highlights the commitment to transparency and accountability in providing care.

As of December 31st, 2023, the following statistics illustrate the impact of the medical home:

Free Monthly Health Checkups
for Senior Citizens

In 2005, Dr. Praful Mehta's fathera retired Teacher Shri. Yashvantrai Surti (Surtisaheb, Valsad) advocated a medical camp for senior citizens at free of cost regularly foreseeing the challenges faced by senior citizens about their health in their retired life with limited income. He also offered his pension income to cover the expenses incurred in organising these medical camps.

Initiating Change: Free Monthly Check-up Camps

Dr. Mehta wholeheartedly embraced this thoughtful suggestion and translated it into action. He initiated FREE MONTHLY MEDICAL CHECK-UP CAMPS for senior citizens at Mehta Hospital, conducting them on the first Sunday of every month. These camps were made possible with the assistance of various consultants who generously provided free consultations. The comprehensive check-ups included vital checks, blood sugar tests, ECGs, and counselling sessions, all aimed at promoting active aging and well-being among the elderly.

Extending Compassionate Care: The Trust's Noble Initiative

After the successful establishment and operation of the Medical Home by the Helping Hand Charitable Trust, the importance of regular health check-ups for senior citizens became even more apparent. Recognizing that many seniors avoid check-ups and fail to adhere to regular medication due to financial constraints following limited sources of income, the Trust undertook this noble project with renewed Vigor in 2012. Shri Sharadbhai Desai, our Trustee, played a crucial role in securing yearly contributions and support from Shri. Dineshbhai Mashru of Mashru Garments for this noble cause. With this support, we were able to accommodate more consultants and facilities in the camp.

Recently, Shri Sharadbhai Desai is actively involved to bring a benefit of medicine

and laboratory investigation at free of cost with support from donors. The initiative received continuous support from the Lions Club of Pardi Pearl, making it a permanent project of the Lions Club.

Impactful Outreach of Medical Camp

This free medical campfor senior citizens benefits to senior citizens include access to thorough health assessments, early detection and prevention of health issues, medical consultations with experienced professionals and specialists in one visit and at one place, provision of essential medications, health education sessions, and the fostering of a supportive community environment. Overall, this transcends to the positive impact of the medical camp facility in improving the overall health and wellbeing of elderly individuals in Pardi and surrounding villages.

Present Registration: 900 Monthly Footfall: 60-70

The data presented highlights the significant impact of the free medical camp facility organized by the Helping Hand Charitable Trust for senior citizens from 2012 to 2024. The total registrations demonstrate the increasing demand for comprehensive health check-ups among elderly individuals, with a steady rise observed each year. Additionally, the monthly footfall for the camp reflects the consistent participation of approximately 50 senior citizens per month, indicating

the ongoing need for such medical services within the senior community.

A Beginning of a New Chapter Dialysis & Kidney Care

In 2015, our esteemed Trustees, Shri Rajubhai Desai along with Shri. Sharadbhai Desai, presented the idea of establishing a <u>DIALYSIS CENTRE</u> in Pardi. Although initially hesitant due to the complexities associated with supervising kidney failure patients, I was eventually convinced to proceed, attributable to the persistence of Mr. Rajubhai Desai and the insistence of donor Shri Bipinbhai Desai. Launching the Project: A Step Forward

To kickstart the project, I offered Mehta Hospital's one deluxe room at free of costfor the dialysis centre's operation. Shouldering the responsibility of



overseeing the centre, we commenced operations with a single dialysis machine. The immediate success and high demand for services led to the acquisition of an additional machine within a mere 15 days.

The establishment of the dialysis center became a reality through the generous donation from Mr. Bipinbhai Desai and the Navjyot Trust Mumbai. Their philanthropic contribution facilitated the setup and operation of the entire dialysis center, equipped with two dialysis machines.

Expanding Capacities: Meeting Growing Needs

The pressing need for dialysis services due to the increasing number of kidney failure patients was evident during the operation of the dialysis.we embarked on the ambitious endeavour of



expanding our dialysis center. we took proactive steps in expanding the existing setup by creating a new dialysis center,

significantly scaling up our capacity and brought the total to seven with genuine efforts from Shri. Rajubhai Desai and Shri. Sharadbhai Desai, following contribution from Mr. Khadawala and Mr. Pravinbhai Desai.





Insights on Dialysis Services

The Helping Hand Charitable Trust and Mehta Hospital Dialysis centreis the only approved facility under Ayushman Bharat Yojana in Pardi. So, this initiative has provided free dialysis services to a significant number of patients.

`The trust conducts an average of 10-12 dialysis procedures per day with an average registration of 25-30 kidney failure patients. These procedures are performed by skilled medical professionals in compliance with established medical protocols and standards. By offering free dialysis, improving access for poorpatients, and easing financial burdens. This initiative leads to better health outcomes, managing kidney-related conditions, and enhancing patients' quality of life. It fosters community support for individuals facing similar health challenges, and patients benefit from receiving care at their doorstep.

Pioneering Prevention: Introducing Kidney Care Initiative Shri. Sharadbhai Desai's vision



we recognised that dialysis alone is not the solution to kidney-related health challenges. Being a silent disease, an awareness about kidney disease, early detection, and prevention with comprehensive care is the key element of treatment. A visionary project was set in motion- The KIDNEY CARE initiative. This transformative initiative is a brainchild of our Trustee Shri. Sharadbhai Desai who was very instrumental in getting the donations for the same and eager to establish an ultramodern transplant facility in pardi. The contribution was received from our usual donor Shri. Siddharth Desai, Paras pumps and with efforts of Mr Ajay Shah by Mr Hemant Zaveri, Badshah masala and Mr. Rajiv Mistry, Accent health care.
